

Membership Criteria

Standing Committee on Therapeutic Trials

- Up to seven members appointed on the recommendation of the Health Research Council of New Zealand, these individuals are responsible for proposal reviews.
- The Chief Executive of the Health Research Council of New Zealand.
- A biostatistician be included, not as a full-time member, but as someone to consult as appropriate.
- A representative to be appointed on the recommendation of the Pharmaceutical Society of New Zealand.
- A nominee of the Ministry of Health attends the AGM for liaison purposes.

Term of Office

Up to three years, appointed members may complete two consecutive terms at which time they would cease to be reappointed for a further three years.

Process for Appointment of Membership

The Chief Executive formally invites the proposed member recommended by the Committee and confirmed by the Health Research Council of New Zealand.
